

Motion: Move that District 4 General Services Structure align with Area 92 General Services and dissolve the Central Office.

Benefits to Adopting this Proposal:

1. District 4 will be a single unified service structure mirroring the WSEA Area 92 Services.
2. The General Service Representative (GSR) will be the focal point of contact for their home group and will carry their groups conscious to the voting assemblies. ("We cannot emphasize too strongly the GSR's importance" The General Service Representative Pamphlet p. 6)
3. A GSR participating in the District Committee will gain a better understanding of Area 92 Conferences, Quarterlies and Assemblies, which will help better serve their home group.
4. The service structure is well documented in the "A. A. General Service Manual" and the pamphlet "The A.A. Group...where it all begins" pg. 19, improving the elections process for service rotations and minimizing the confusion of service roles. Current volunteers feel the need to serve several rotations due to the lack of "fellowship availability". The simplified structure would emphasize "the spirit of rotation".
5. The District Committee would continue to one meeting per month, reducing redundant trusted servant positions, such as secretary and treasurer. Rotations would maximize volunteers in the fellowship to step up as committee chairs or volunteer on a committee.
6. The District Committee Treasurer will have one budget to manage. The two treasuries would be combined and continue to fund the elected positions and committees. Home group contributions would fund the one service structure, the District Committee, rather than splitting contributions between the two service structures.
